Most victims of housing discrimination do not report it.

Today housing discrimination is subtle and sophisticated, which makes it harder to detect. Know your housing rights. According to the federal Fair Housing Act, it's illegal to consider race, color, religion, national origin, sex, disability or familial status in rental, sales, lending or homeowner's insurance decisions.
